Having members positively engaged in supporting the club is the best way to use the resources of the club. It is also the best way that members can benefit from the club through social networks, physical activity, and the joys of sailing.

All applicants who sign up to become members of Nedlands Yacht Club need to agree they are willing to be active members of the Club regarding sailing and volunteering.

This can be demonstrated by:

- Competing in Sunday racing events
- Sailing in company
- Social sailing
- Attending Social events
- Attending Busy Bees
- Volunteering for duties for Sunday racing
- Volunteering to be on a Committee

All memberships will be reviewed for examples of active membership in any of the above ways.

Inactive members may be invited by the Management Committee to explain why they have not participated and will be encouraged to look for opportunities to participate in Club activities.

If the level of active participation does not improve within an agreed timeframe the Management Committee may decide to notify the member that their membership will not be accepted for the following season and all storage facilities options will not be available.
